A summary of our expenditures for the 1979 season is as follows:



All perpetual trophies have been returned and engraved with the names of the 1979 winning yachts. They have been polished and are ready for presentation at the Annual Meeting this evening. Keeper plaques for Firsts and brass plaques for Seconds and Thirds have also been obtained for presentation.

In addition we have already purchased the prizes for the 1980 Spring and Fall Series at a cost of \$1,710.00 in order to get in ahead of anticipated price increases in some cases almost double those of 1979 price lists. This figure compares to \$1,990.82 in 1979 and \$1,786.14 in 1978.
