

Your Governors hope as many as possible will be with us for another fine Off Soundings Club party.

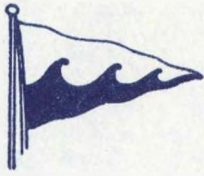
