After careful consideration the committee decided on June 21-22 as ideal because it will enable the Western Sound members to take in our race and see the start of the Bermuda Race the following week.

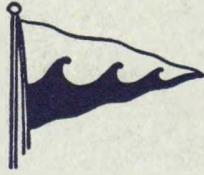
We want to make this one of our old inimitable Off Soundings Races, and we urge you to start right away to line up your boat-owner friends to be there.
