## Prizes & Awards Committee Report

Commodore Robinson,

Members of the Board of Governors,  
of the Off Soundings Club:

The Keepers Plaques for the 11 winners of the Annual Class Trophies will cost from the J. S. Packard Corp. the same as last year \$26.50 each or \$291.50 total.

The Keeper Plaques for the 22 second and third place boats which were ordered last year for the first time from the Martingale Company will cost slightly more than last year.

The work was very well done and took Martingale more time than they anticipated. Therefore they have had to raise the quote from \$9.50 each last year to \$12.50 each this year, or a total for the 22 plates of \$275.00 up from \$209.00 last year.

With your approval I will order both sets of Keeper Plaques and have them ready for presentation April 1st.

Still to be decided upon is a special bulkhead plaque award.

At the end of January I will write to the holders of the permanent trophies to return them for engraving and in some cases photographing so that they will also be ready for presentation April 1st. to the new winners.
