### N O T I C E

Referring to our notice of April 29th 1946 the buoy for the second mark of the first day's Long Course was moved about March 2nd. This will require a change of courses which will be sent you in the final notice.

There were two typographical errors in setting forth the formula of the Off Soundings rule sent you. The corrected rule is enclosed herewith.

Please destroy the first copy and substitute the enclosed.

There seems to be some confusion in regard to the "foretriangle". This is not the "sail area" of jib or jibs, but is the triangle formed as follows:

Base C = the distance from the foreside of mast to intersection of the outermost stay on which any sail is set and the stem or bowsprit.

Perpendicular D = the distance from the deck proper, not the cabin house, to the point of attachment of the highest halyard block on the mast or the intersection of the headstay and the mast, whichever is higher.
