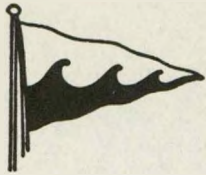

RESOLVED, that annual Winter Party be held at Springfield on March 17th.


There was a discussion relative to possibly changing the Off Soundings Club Rule in respect to yachts of light displacement. No action taken.
