

OFF SOUNDINGS RACE - SECOND DAY

The second and final day of the 30th Annual Spring Off Soundings Series began with a fresh but dying south-westerly breeze, left over from the previous day. The first leg of the course for all six classes was a close reach to the Greenport bell. From there it was "up spinnakers" for the four larger classes on a run to Constellation Rock, while the two smaller classes (B2 and C2) had a spinnaker reach to Crow Shoal.

Breezes slackened to cause the crews frustration on these legs, but never did they experience the agonizing flat calms which blighted the second day of last fall's series, although the larger boats were becalmed several times.

Next for the small boats it was long and short tacks to the Sag Harbor nun, with the ability to outguess fickle breezes being the prime ingredient for success. The boats which picked the Long Island shore looked in bad shape for a while, as the breeze filled in from the westward, but they picked up a nice slant and came screaming up out of the tank in fine style.

Once around Sag Harbor nun, the breeze filled in from the south west, with the boats which stayed to weather faring slightly better. Spinnakers were soon popped, and the boats broad-reached in to the finish in the kind of sunny summer weather that makes you glad to be alive.

On the long leg out to Constellation the larger boats were forced to anchor several times, as the breeze disappeared. Fluky breezes at the mark caused anxious moments for many skippers, and they sailed upwind in light airs, part way to the weather mark, where they picked up the southwest breeze that the smaller boats had enjoyed earlier. From there on, around Sag Harbor nun, it was freshening breezes, with some boats even changing down to smaller genoas on the beat. The spinnaker reach to the finish made a glorious end to a fine racing series, with only Class B1 experiencing the disappointment of "no race", due to the first boat finishing seven minutes after the time limit expired.
