A MESSAGE FROM THE COMMODORE

This Spring Race Series will certainly be remembered for its frustrations. Friday's complete lack of air at times, was trying indeed, but Saturday's dense fog, coupled with starting line problems, made it truly difficult for all concerned. Because of these problems it was necessary for the Protest Committee to declare Class A-2 No Race.

All the class winners in Saturday's race deserve particular commendation for their performance under such adverse conditions.

May I point out to our newer members, that over the years, it has been an Off Soundings policy to hold races in ALL KINDS OF WEATHER, but only if, in the judgment of the Race Committee, it is SAFE to do so. This policy continues to be in effect.

You will be interested to know that your officers have taken positive action with respect to improving communications and eliminating starting line problems. For future races the stake boat will have VHF to enable it to communicate better with the Committee Boat. Also, race information will be broadcast on BOTH 2638 and Channel 9 at specified intervals as well as at other necessary times.

The starting line for Course #2 will be moved closer to Block Island in order to eliminate the problems that were caused by the deep water and fast current set.

Attention is called to the requirement that all boats must be either identified by the Committee Boat as a finisher, or submit a written withdrawal to the Race Secretary to have the race count in working off penalties.

To conclude on a happy note -- Despite the adversities, we did not have a single accident. Our entire fleet is to be congratulated for their good seamanship. Of equal significance was the good sportsmanship displayed by numerous skippers who voluntarily withdrew when they found they had failed to meet certain of the race requirements.

Please be reminded of the following changes voted last January:

1. A "cruising canvas" class will be run on a trial basis in 1974. Because of the frequency of light airs, the conventional definition has been modified. The only sail you cannot fly is a spinnaker. Four prizes will be given; however, a perpetual prize has not been established at this time. Vessels must meet all Off Soundings requirements. Your normal rating will be used in calculating handicaps. You must put a check in the appropriate box on the entry form to be eligible!
2. To qualify to race in the Spring 1975 Series and thereafter, your vessel must meet all NAYRU Category 4 requirements, including lifelines and pulpits, currently waived through the 1974 season. NAYRU specifications for lifelines and pulpits will be waived if your vessel meets M.O.R.C. requirements and you certify that you have a valid M.O.R.C. Certificate. Catboats may apply for a waiver for lifelines and pulpits.

Entry Procedure

Off Soundings Club races are open to those members and guest vessels which qualify in all respects to the provisions outlined in this FIRST NOTICE.

1. Please be reminded that our rules require that at least one of the persons in whose name the vessel is entered must be on board for both races and must be in command of the yacht.

For reasons of space please do not list more than two names! If yours is a syndicate boat and you wish to list the syndicate name indicate the skipper's name only.

2. Complete the enclosed Entry Blank and send by First Class Mail postmarked on or before August 19th to Donald P. Robinson, Mystic Seaport, Mystic, Connecticut 06355.
3. Have a valid measurement certificate. A valid measurement certificate is one that is less than three years old, i.e. with original date of September 14, 1971 or later, providing that each alteration subsequently made which affects the measured factors entering into the rating has been reflected by revision to that certificate. Please read and complete your Entry Blank carefully. If the yacht does not have a valid certificate, it must be measured by one of the measurers shown on the enclosed list of OSC measurers, your yacht club measurer, or a Yachting Association measurer. The certificate should be completed in triplicate, with one copy being sent to Richard H. Roberts, Off Soundings Club Measurer, 60 Dart Street, New London, Connecticut 06320, postmarked not later than August 19, 1974. Your measurer should keep one copy. The third copy is for your files.

The closing date for entries is the latest practical date and will be rigidly adhered to. No exceptions will be made.

Contributions from Entrants

Your contribution of \$4.00 per person on board is vital to the continued success of our Off Soundings Races. Please make your check payable to the Off Soundings Club and enclose it with your Entry Blank.

Guest Vessel Invitation

To prevent our Off Soundings classes from getting dangerously large, the closing date for guest invitations was set at March 29, for both the Spring and Fall Series. No more guests may be invited for 1974 racing.

Only two invitations will be issued to any acceptable non-member to participate in our racing events, each invitation being sufficient for any two (2) consecutive race series, such as Spring '75 and Fall '75, or Fall '75 and Spring '76.

Yacht Eligibility

- I. The minimum rating for any yacht sailing in the OSC Annual Race Series is 18 feet. Yachts whose ratings calculate lower than this 18-foot minimum shall race using this 18-foot rating.
- II. The minimum L.O.A. of vessels which may race in the OSC Annual Race Series is 23.75 feet. Vessels smaller than this L.O.A. will not be permitted to race, nor will vessels in excess of 62 feet L.O.A.

III. Excepted from this ruling are vessels owned by members which fall below these minimums but which have raced in a series prior to this action. These vessels will be permitted to race using ratings shown on the vessel's valid rating certificate, so long as there is no change in vessel's ownership.

Preliminary Racing and Rendezvous Information

The fleet will again race in Block Island Sound waters this year. The start will be off Watch Hill and the finish off the entrance to Great Salt Pond the first day.

Note!!

You must fly a class pennant at all times during the race. This pennant shall be no smaller than size "0" i.e. 12" x 15". It should be flown vertically as far forward as possible on the pulpit.

If your vessel does not have a pulpit (and only in this circumstance) it must be flown from your backstay approximately 5 feet above the deck.

This will be of great assistance to all participants while racing, and will aid the Race Committee as it finishes over 200 boats. Failure to fly the pennant is not a reason for disqualification.

Those owners unsure of their boat's class may call my office after August 27th.

Your vessel must meet NAYRU Category 4 requirements; the requirement for lifelines and pulpits has been waived for the 1974 races, but will be required for the Spring 1975 races. Lifelines and pulpits must meet NAYRU specifications unless you certify that you have a valid M.O.R.C. Certificate.

Please note that on your entry blank you are asked to certify that your vessel conforms.

The Friday and Saturday night rendezvous will be held at "The Oar" adjacent to the Block Island Marina.

You should make your own reservations for slips, etc. early and directly.

NAYRU Sail Numbers

North American Yacht Racing Union requirements regarding sail numbers are mandatory for Off Soundings participation. Class insignia, however, may continue to be displayed.

Other Racing Information

Handicap penalties for winners are 15% for the first place, 10% for second place, and 5% for third place, with a maximum penalty of 45%.

Handicap penalties will be carried for three race series. To work off a penalty you must start both races and either be identified as a finisher or submit a written withdrawal as soon as possible to the Race Secretary.

The division of classes will be announced in the FINAL NOTICE.

Club Ties and Patches
