A summary of our expenditures for the 1980 season is as follows.



Note that 24 seconds separate the first and second places in Class A-1, that there are 74 seconds between first and second places in Class C-3, and that second and third places in Cruising Canvas Class are 14 seconds apart. In addition, two fourth-place yachts were less than a minute out of third: Class C-1 - BLIXTAR (17 seconds) and Class C-2 - LEPRECHAUN (44 Seconds).
