This is a team race regatta; an individual's performance is not scored, only his class.

As many races as time permits will be run, all straight competitive (Except one, later determined by the Deep Six Committee, which may be scored backwards in accordance with Gardners Bay wind vagaries), no protests sustained except those initiated by the Committee.
