Dear Skipper:

The OFF SOUNDINGS CLUB takes pleasure in extending a cordial invitation to the 1962 Bermuda Race entrants to participate in our 25th Annual Spring Race Series.

If your entry for the 1962 Bermuda Race has been accepted, if your yacht is 62 feet or less in overall length, and if you comply with the requirements for measurement and entry as described in the enclosed First Notice you are eligible for this race series.

The races start from New London, Connecticut, on Friday, June 8th, racing over a 25 mile course to Montauk Harbor, Long Island. The following day, the race is from Montauk Harbor to Three Mile Harbor, Long Island, over a 25 mile open triangular course in Gardiners Bay. An informal shore party and rendezvous will be held following each race.

The only measurements that are required by the OFF SOUNDINGS CLUB RULE that are not on the Cruising Club certificate are the maximum beam and the area of the largest headsail (excluding spinnakers) that you will carry aboard during the races. Your C.C.A. Measurer should be asked to take these measurements at the time he measures your yacht for the Bermuda Race, fill out the O.C.S. certificates and forward it as described in the enclosed First Notice.

A Final Notice will be mailed June 2nd giving courses, starting times, boat numbers, etc..

We hope that you will be able to accept this invitation so that we may have the pleasure of your company in June.
