Do not make any reservations through the Off Soundings Club.

Special low rates have been obtained for our use at the following establishments. Kindly make your reservations directly with them no later than June 1st, accompanied by a down payment of 50 per cent.

Osborne Residence: 200 yards from Maidstone Marina. Rates \$10—single, \$12.50—double. Reservations: Mrs. E. Monroe Osborne, Three Mile Harbor Road, East Hampton, N. Y. 5 rooms.

Hunting Inn: East Hampton, 28 rooms \$10—single, \$12—double. Reservations: Mr. Laundau, Sherry Netherlands Hotel, New York, New York.

Sea Spray Inn: 125 rooms \$10—single, \$15—double. Reservations: Mr. Arnold Bailey, Sea Spray Inn, Ocean Avenue, East Hampton, New York.
