37th ANNUAL FALL RACE RESULTS

The enclosed results certainly indicate that the caliber of racing, as reflected by the closeness of corrected times, has not diminished, in spite of the reduced number of participants. The Cruising Canvas Class appears to have filled a need for a number of members.

Your Committees have a long list of items to study this winter and the Commodore plans to start on them soon.

Just a few items to be reviewed are: classification of certain vessels, a relook at the rules, in light of 1974 performances by a few new designs, radio frequencies to be used, use of Kevlar sails, possibly some starting and finishing line changes. We have received a number of good letters of suggestion and would encourage more. These will be helpful to the Committee's efforts.

Please review your rating certificate now and remember that revisions to Measurement Certificates do not extend the original expiration date for your certificate. Get remeasured in the Fall and avoid the Spring panic party!

Guest invitations for the 1975 Spring and Fall Races should be in my hands before March, 1975. The exact date will be established at our Governors' Meeting in January.


