FINAL RESULTS

Attached are the final results of the 28th Annual Fall Race Series. Entries totalled 174 with 134 competing.

All corrected times are figures from the starting time of the first class. To compare corrected times of boats in different classes, the time difference between class starts must be taken into account. After all of our copy was completed I was informed by our esteemed chairman of the Race Committee that they had taken all times from the first gun, which is 8:50. Therefore, add ten minutes to any of your individual times as a correction factor.

From time to time guests and members call the Race Secretary one or two days, or even a day after, the entry closing date stating that they never received the first notices and that they did not know the closing date, etc. For everyone's information, please be advised that the dates for the Spring and Fall Series do not vary more than a few days from year to year nor do the time intervals between the First Notice, Closing Date for Entries, etc. vary by more than a day or two. The Race Secretary has no means of knowing whether you received your notices and you will get very little sympathy by calling up a day before the closing date for entries asking where your first notices have been. It is up to you to get in touch with the Race Secretary if you have not received your various notices. For your information we are enclosing the schedule that we used this year and which as set forth above, will not vary by more than a few days for any year hence.

On Saturday, September 18th, there was a protest filed by Henry B. duPont against GEORJABELLE and SOUTHERN CROSS. After considerable deliberation by the Protest Committee both GEORJABELLE AND SOUTHERN CROSS were upheld. However, it is our understanding that Mr. duPont plans to file an appeal with NAYRU. The results of this appeal will be extremely interesting and may end up in the re-writing of rules.


