

OFF SOUNDINGS RACE - SECOND DAY

Due to strong northeasterly winds from the fringes of hurricane Doria, the course for the second day of the 30th Annual Fall Off Soundings Series was shortened to 15.1 miles for all six classes. The race started off Three-Mile Harbor, Long Island, where many skippers had spent an anxious night tending anchors in gale-force blasts from the northeast. The start was postponed for one hour to allow the committee time to decide whether to start the race.

Most boats started under shortened sail for the reach to Greenport bell, and the beat to Crow Shoal. More adventuresome skippers set spinnakers on the run to Sag Harbor nun, while many were content with working sail. The final reach to the finish was at hull speed for most of the boats. Rudder problems dogged the second day as well as the first, as Paul Van Dyke's Channel Fever was forced to drop out for this reason. The Class A-1 yawl Moorea lead the fleet across the finish, but dropped to 14th place on corrected time, because she carried a 25% additional handicap by former winnings, as is customary with Off Soundings.

The shore party at Shelter Island was blessed with sunshine and moderating winds, as crews met and swapped yarns of the race on the lawns of the Shelter Island Yacht Club.
