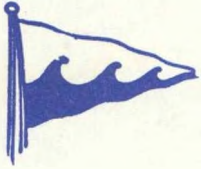

All members and guests are cordially invited to this program whether or not they have dinner tickets.


