### TO ALL 1966 BERMUDA & TRANSATLANTIC RACE ENTRANTS

The Off Soundings Club takes this opportunity to invite all Bermuda and TransAtlantic Race entrants to participate in our 29th Annual Spring Race Series. These races start from New London, June 10th, racing to Three Mile Harbor with a triangular course in Gardiner's Bay taking place June 11th. The rendezvous Friday night will be at the Maidstone Marina, Three Mile Harbor and on Saturday night at the Shelter Island Yacht Club.

The Board of Governors of the Off Soundings Club have voted to establish a special class, for yachts wishing to participate, that are in excess of our maximum overall length of 62 feet. Depending on the number of entires in this "oversize class", a trophy or trophies will be presented to the winner.

Your entry blank must be filed postmarked no later than May 20th. In order to participate an Off Soundings Club Measurement Certificate will have to be filed with our Club Measurer, William L. Ames, 9 Gravel Street, Mystic, Connecticut, postmarked no later than May 20th. This should be filled in by the measurer at the time he measures your boat for the Bermuda and/or TransAtlantic Race. The only measurement required that is not on the C.C.A. Certificate is the maximum beam, and the length of luff of largest headsail.

Enclosed is our First Notice of this Race Series together with Measurement Certificates, Entry Blanks and General Instruction. Final Notice of the courses, your boat number, and other information will be mailed to you June 3rd. Please show on your Entry Blank the mailing address for this Final Notice.

We hope we shall have the pleasure of your company this June.
