THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 15, 1988

Burr's Yacht Haven at New London can provide Off Soundings participants moorings for Thursday night or from the preceding weekend at his normal rates. (Committee Boat EMPRESS will be at Burr's Thursday night.) Please contact the dockmaster upon arrival for docking and/or rafting instructions. It is not necessary, but, to be on the safe side, if you wish to make advanced reservations, contact Burr's, 244 Pequot Avenue, New London, CT. 06320. Telephone: (203) 443-8457. Launch service will be available, and adequate space for anchoring is available. The launch service is available up until 8:00 p.m. Thursday evening. If you expect to require service after that hour, you should make your own arrangements. Lighted municipal parking is located a block away for weekend parking. Please do not use Burr's in-yard parking for the entire weekend as it is reserved for their regular clientele.

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 1988

The Shelter Island Yacht Club at Dering Harbor, Shelter Island, New York will be the site of the weekend rendezvous.

DOCKING AND MOORING

Moorings will be available on a first-come first-serve basis as pointed out by the harbor master at the Club. A charge of \$10.00 per night will be made for each yacht on a mooring, whether directly moored or rafted. Please note message at the bottom of Page 1 of this notice. This charge is the same as last year and goes directly to Off Soundings Club, (not SIYC). Our financial viability depends on those who take advantage of this convenience paying for it. Anchoring is always acceptable and there is good holding in sandy mud.

LAUNCH SERVICE

There will be launches flying the Shelter Island Yacht Club burgee available for transportation ashore from 1:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. Friday and 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. Saturday and on Sunday a.m. Please note that the last ferry from Greenport is at midnight. The launch schedule is rigid, so plan accordingly.

REFRESHMENTS

Spigotted crocks will be arranged north of the clubhouse and may be readily identified by the code flags properly arrayed. Timely finishes permitted, mainbrace splicing will commence at 1730. Please assist in keeping the grounds neat and tidy by using the trash barrels available.

Friday evening, after the race results, the Shelter Island Yacht Club is serving a chicken B-B-Q Dinner at \$17.00 per person, including tax and tip.
