We are attaching hereto final instruction sheet with starting times and courses. We also enclose a list of entries by classes giving their ratings and time allowances.

It is not too late for any who wish to contribute to the "Liquidating Fund". Thanks are extended to all who have already contributed.

The Montauk Yacht Club has kindly opened their club house Friday evening, June 21st to all members of the fleet. (See special notice attached). The Montauk Yacht Club will provide launch service.

The Entertainment Committee will be on hand from 5:00 P.M. on.

The Shelter Island Yacht Club have very kindly opened their club house to all members of the fleet Saturday, June 22nd, where the Entertainment Committee will again be on hand and where announcement of winners will be made. The Shelter Island Yacht Club will provide launch service.

We are continuing the additional handicap of 10% to former first prize winners and 5% to former second prize winners, limited to winners for a two year period, maximum 25%.

PRIZES

In each class if three or more yachts start the first day, there will be a first prize. If five or more a second prize. If twelve or more a third prize. The prizes will be awarded on the basis of the lowest corrected total time for the two days.

The United States Coast Guard Academy has very graciously offered to provide the 75' schooner Innisfail to act as Committee Boat. The club wishes to extend sincere thanks for their cooperation.

Newcomers to our race will find that they are run in an informal manner. However, all right of way rules are strictly enforced.

The Race Committee will meet immediately after each race to determine the winners. We do not expect to be able to give the standing of all boats immediately, but complete standings of all yachts will be mailed to the owners as soon as possible after the races.
