### Spring and Fall 1987 Race Series - 50th Off Soundings Race Committee

I would like to make some recommendations to the Board of Governors, and I thought it would be helpful if I put some ideas down that have been suggested by this special committee.

- 1) Plaques awarded to all members of the Off Soundings Club. The plaques will show a chart of our two sailing grounds - Gardner Bay and Block Island. Each chart will show Off Soundings Club 50th Annual Series 1987. Carl is working on this project.

Distribution of plaques to all members:

- a) Given to members at our 1987 Annual Dinner
- b) Balance mailed out later in the year

### 2) Special Prizes

- a) Prize for the skipper who has raced the most number of series and is racing in the Spring ~~and~~ <sup>either</sup> Fall 1987 series.
- b) Prizes for those that had participated in our 25th race in 1962 and are racing in either the 1987 Spring or Fall series.
- c) A prize for the 1987 skipper in each class who wins on corrected time, has raced his own boat built prior to 1980 and has completed a minimum of 10 races in either the Spring or Fall series. Winners of 1, 2, 3 & 4th places are not eligible.
- d) Qualifiers for these prizes (a, b, c) would be determined by a questionnaire sent to our members at the time of our billing for the 1987 dues.

These prizes would be awarded at the annual 1988 dinner.

Total budget - Plaques, Prizes, Invitees - \$2,500???

- 3) Our historian to submit to the Commodore names of distinguished sailors that could be invited to the series races or annual dinner. (An open invitation would be extended, meaning no entry fee.)
