Dear Members and Guests:

Attached are the results of our Fall Race Series at Shelter Island and the list of Perpetual Trophy winners (Members, without penalties) for the year 1992 as well as for the winners in the combined Classes A-1/A-2, C-1/C-2 and C-4/C-5 for the years 1991 and 1992.

Once again, the weather provided good racing and fun both Spring and Fall, this year. And, in one class, only 47 seconds separated First and Second Place, after four days of racing. Each of you should think a minute and recall where you may have squandered a total of 47 seconds somewhere in those four races. You must keep up your guard and pay attention every moment!

As a reminder, the closing date for receiving "Guest Invitation" requests for the 1993 Spring and Fall Race Series is March 18, 1993. Invitation applications must be in the hands of the Race Secretary on or before that date.

Prior to Saturday's race, a member of the Race Committee, George Mettler, collapsed on board the Committee Boat, FREEDOM. Fleet Surgeon Chet Humphrey brought HERITAGE alongside and provided medical assistance. He radioed the Greenport Hospital and made arrangements for Mettler to be met by an ambulance at Townsend Marina in Sterling Harbor (adjacent to the hospital). Mettler was transported to the marina in HELIX, the small launch owned and used by Mystic Seaport's Ken Mahler in making the video recordings of our races. The Race Secretary, in LEPRECHAUN, provided Mahler with directions to Townsend Marina. Fleet Surgeon Humphrey returned to HERITAGE and made ready to compete in Class A-1. The rendering of assistance delayed his preparations for his start and he was awarded a reduction in elapsed time of five minutes. Mettler was released Saturday afternoon, but had a recurrence later in the day and was returned to the hospital. He was subsequently transferred to a hospital near New York City and is reported to be recovering. This episode has brought home the worth of our practice of hiring an intern and of maintaining a list of eight or ten physicians who are racing but who have agreed to be "on call" to respond to a medical need throughout the fleet during each of our races. Knowing that that sort of help is "at the ready" should be a source of comfort for all of us; we are grateful.

Remember that the Mystic Seaport has a fine collection of videos of our Off Soundings Club races. These are great for your get-togethers over the winter.




