The staff of the Seaport Planetarium will be conducting a preview of the morning and evening stars available for the 1974 Bermuda Race.

The special half hour star preview in the planetarium will be conducted Monday 29 April at 1930 E.D.T. and repeated Monday 20 May at 1930 E.D.T. The stars and planets are to be shown and identified as they will appear from the mid point of of the Newport-to-Bermuda rhumb line during the race.

Following the presentation in the Planetarium, a short Day's Work Review Problem will be done to refresh interested participants in the Nautical Almanac, Sight Reduction Tables and use of the star finder. There will be a charge of \$2.00 for the star preview and review session which should take about two hours.
