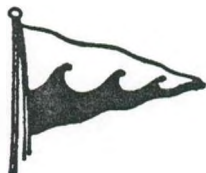

Comments regarding proposal by Reinhard Sarges to classify light weight boats in a separate class (Race Secretary report)

The C-classes were regrouped beginning in 1986 and continuing through 1990, such that Class C-3 had exclusively lighter displacement boats and other boats that are fast for their length. There were no numerical criteria for this class.

- o Fast boats were culled from classes C-2 and C-4. Lighter boats remained in classes C-1 and C-5, including the J-24s and Devlin 24 in class C-5.
- o Long range planning committee discussions during the winter of 1990-1991 concluded that it would be preferable to break classes by PHRF number and to adjust handicaps as necessary. Handicaps of J-24, Evelyn 25, Evelyn 26MH, and Noe 27 were subsequently reduced.

If we were to regroup the fast boats to a separate class, based on the Fall 1996 entry list:

- o Only six boats in classes C-4 and C-5 can be identified as light weight boats. These are:

A seventh boat, the Evelyn 25.5 PROPHET, can be classified as a fast boat for length.

- o Three boats in class C-3 can be identified as light weight boats/ fast boats for length.

However, it would not be appropriate to race these boats on the short course.

It is submitted that a fast boat class cannot be reasonably defined to include C-5 boats because if insufficient fast/light boats in classes C-4 and C-5
