1. It was agreed that all the names on the present Mailing List be dropped and in the future upon the request of three (3) members invitations to race will be sent to non-members for only two (2) consecutive series of races (i.e. Spring and Fall or Fall and Spring). These would then be dropped unless sponsored again by three (3) members or elected to membership. The Board of Governors wishes to call to the attention of the members that people invited to sail in our races should be of membership material only.
2. It was agreed that penalties applied to past prize winners would hold through three (3) series of races in which the boat under the same owner sailed and not for two (2) years as at present.
3. Commodore Stephens and Mr. White are to investigate the problem of the Race Committee Boat and report back at the next meeting.
4. Mr. White is to suggest a revision of Article XI of the Constitution at the next meeting.
5. There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
