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UP-DATE ON NAVIGATIONAL INFORMATION

The following information has recently been received from the Coast Guard:

1. The change of the finish line buoy (it is also Mark "A" for Saturday) has been accomplished. The new buoy, a red and white vertically striped whistle buoy having a red spherical topmark and showing a white Mo(A) light, is in the same location as the buoy it replaced.
2. While Mark "E" has not been changed, these nearby changes have been made and should be noted:
 - a. Can "1" has been relocated about 300 yards eastward, to
L 41° 03' 07.2" N Lo 72° 14' 05.7" W
 - b. The black and red can at Dangerous Rock has been discontinued.
3. These changes are of interest to those proceeding from the finish to Dering Harbor:
 - a. Lighted Gong Buoy "2" has been discontinued.
 - b. Lighted Bell Buoy "4" has been relocated about 300 yards eastward, to
L 41° 06' 13.0" N Lo 72° 18' 15.0" W
and has been renumbered to "2".
 - c. Black and red can at Dering Harbor entrance has been discontinued.
4. Watch Hill Light Radio Beacon is in service, transmitting on 306 kHz, sequence V, characteristic WH (.-.).
