Dear Members and Guests:

Attached are the results of our Fall Race Series at Shelter Island, together with the list of Perpetual Trophy winners (members only, and without penalties) for the year 1996. This includes the winners in the combined Classes A-1/A-2, C-1/C-2 and C-4/C-5 for the years 1995 and 1996.

You will note that the times for the Perpetual Trophies are reasonably close, but none so close as for the Beauford H. Reeves Memorial Trophy for Class C-1, where first and third places differ by only 129 seconds.

We were able to give Classes C-1, C-2 and C-3 two races on Saturday, both in the Spring and in the Fall. Those yachts began finishing only minutes after the rest of the fleet completed their starting sequence, and we were able to send them off on a "normal" course for their second race.


We were forced to involve a General Recall in the second races -- in the Spring because of an error in the Starting Procedure and, in the Fall, because too many yachts crowded over the line at the start of Class C-1. The "Round the Ends Rule" (sometimes called the "One Minute Rule") was then placed into effect (through the display of Code Flag "I") and all three second race classes then were started without incident. For those unsure of what to do when Code Flag "I" is displayed, attention is invited to Racing Rules 4.1 "I" and 51.1(c).

There was enough consternation, and even confusion, about the General Recalls to warrant the outline on "General Recalls and the Off Soundings Club" found on the reverse of this memo.

We invite your comments on any or all aspects of this year's racing (for that matter, on any subject you'd like). Send your thoughts to me or to Commodore Gunther. The Board of Governors meets on October 26th and it would be helpful to have your thoughts before then.

Remember that the Mystic Seaport has a fine collection of videos of our Off Soundings Club races. These are great for your get-togethers over the winter.

# General Recalls and the Off Soundings Club

## What the Rules Say

1. When there is a number of unidentified premature starters, the Race Committee may make a General Recall signal.
2. The recalled class will start next, and subsequent classes will be delayed accordingly.
3. The next signal for the recalled start is the Preparatory Signal.

## Off Soundings Club Policy

1. Off Soundings has added wording which permits using a General Recall after an error in starting procedure. Without this, an abandonment signal would be required (with its three guns, which could be confusing to already-started classes), and we have stated that an abandoned race will not be resailed. Alternatively, a Postponement could be used, if the Race Committee could get it done before the Starting Signal.
2. For a rolling starting sequence (the Start of one class is the Preparatory for the next class)
  - a. We require that a recalled class will start after the last scheduled class (if more than one class, in the order recalled), on the grounds that recalling a class for a new start should not penalize the following classes by having them wait. Note that no sound signal will be made in conjunction with the lowering of the General Recall signal -- that is, the rolling sequence just keeps rolling.
  - b. We specify that the Start Signal for the last normal-sequence in the rolling sequence will be the Preparatory Signal for the first recalled class.
3. For a ten-minute starting sequence
  - a. We do not use a rolling starting sequence for the second race on Saturday because, if one class is delayed in finishing the first race, we don't want to hold up the other classes while waiting for it. So, we have provided that each of those classes having a second race is to have an independent ten-minute starting sequence (starting with a Warning Signal in each case), to be used in any order, as selected by the Race Committee and signalled by the Class Flag.
  - b. For a General Recall occurring in one of those ten-minute starting sequences used for the second race on Saturday, we have specified that a complete, new ten-minute sequence will be used (starting with the Warning Signal). Whether this is to take place next, or later, depends upon how quickly the class can be brought back, which class will be sailing through which classes on the race course, etc., and is the call of the Race Committee. In any case, the Class Flag is used to indicate which class is being given the ten-minute starting sequence. Note that no sound signal will be made in conjunction with the lowering of the General Recall signal -- it's not needed because each sequence is independent.
4. The Sailing Instructions state that Rules 4.1"First Substitute", 4.2(d) and 7.2(a) are modified to incorporate the Off Soundings Club procedures.
