Our Annual Meeting and Spring Dinner will be held at the United States Coast Guard Academy in New London, Connecticut on Saturday, April 8, 2000.

The Annual Meeting for members will be held downstairs in the Tap Room of the Officers Club at 1800:

1. For election of Officers and Board of Governors for this coming year.
2. To transact any business that may properly come before the meeting.

Cocktails will be served in the Alumni Room of the Officers Club, which is adjacent to the Dining Room, at 1800 on a buy-your-own basis. "Rock of Ages" will provide music during cocktails.

A fine dinner with all the trimmings will be served promptly at 1930 in the Dining Room of the Officers Club. Members, crew, and guests are cordially invited to cocktails, dinner or both. If you plan to sit with a group, come early and stake out a table.

This year we are offering a choice of entrees. Filet Mignon or Baked Salmon with Cardinale Sauce each at \$30.00 per plate (including tax and gratuities). These prices are for advance payment. We will charge \$32.00 per person at the door. If you plan to pay at the door, you should call ahead to make sure that we can make arrangements to accommodate you.

The after dinner program, starting at 2030, will include the awarding of perpetual trophies and the showing of an excellent video entitled "Off Soundings in the Nineteen Hundreds" featuring some 60 years of our club's sailing. Of special interest will be the change in yacht construction from wood to glass and cruising to flat out racing hulls.
