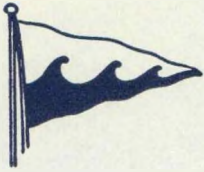

1. To act on the following proposed changes in the By-Laws as approved by the Board of Governors at its meeting on January 19, 1961:

To amend Article VI, Section 1, so as to provide for automatic inclusion of the Measurer on the Board of Governors.

To amend Article X, Section 1, in a similar way.

These Articles as amended would read as follows:

ARTICLE VI

Section 1 - There shall be a Board of Governors which shall meet at least twice a year and shall consist of the Commodore, Vice Commodore, Rear Commodore, Clerk, Secretary, Race Secretary, Treasurer, Measurer, and five other members. The Commodore will be Chairman of the Board of Governors.

ARTICLE X

Section 1 - Commodore, Vice Commodore, Rear Commodore, Clerk, Secretary, Race Secretary, Treasurer, Measurer, Historian, and five members of the Board of Governors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Club, and shall hold office for one year or until their successors are elected.

2. The election of Officers and Board of Governors for the ensuing year.
3. To transact any business that may properly come before the meeting.
