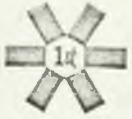

Nice to talk to you this morning, and I thought I would just confirm our conversation about the new trophy. There follows a suggested paragraph for the Spring Notices:


