Friday, June 11

The Maidstone Marina at Three Mile Harbor, East Hampton, New York, will host the rendezvous. Mr. and Mrs. Stephen A. Taxi service is available.

Docking and Mooring: The fifteen 300 pound mushroom moorings are on a first-come, first-served basis (\$2.50/night). Dock space at \$2.50/night (Fleet rate) must be reserved in advance. (Maximum draft 5-1/2 feet at Marina Dock - check latest chart for depths elsewhere.)

Dinner: A choice of L. I. Duckling at a cost of \$3.50/person or Lazy Lobster, fresh from Montauk, \$4.50/person. Reservations for dinner (with payment enclosed) must be made in advance to facilitate planning. Reservations will be confirmed; people with reservations will be served first.
