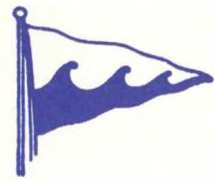

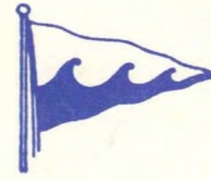

To the Members:

Another successful Fall Race Series has concluded and I do not think anyone would argue too seriously with the good luck we had with the weather. So far as I know, good racing was enjoyed by everyone though the elapsed times were perhaps longer than would be desired because of the adverse effect upon the availability of results. We regret that necessary rigid enforcement of our entry deadlines might have disappointed some of the regular participants but, in fairness to all, your Commodore and Race Secretary could pursue no other course.

I am sure that the membership would join me in thanking all of the hard-working committee chairmen and the members for looking after the various responsibilities that a race for 185 boats and the number of people thus involved require. Members and guests alike pitched in when help was needed. We are all painfully aware of the Launch Service at Three Mile Harbor and your governors will be giving a great deal of attention this winter to efforts to alleviate a bad situation before the Spring Series.

Unfortunately, in spite of continued reminders, some things happened over the weekend that just shouldn't, and your Commodore is acutely aware of one such event. My dinghy was borrowed Saturday night or Sunday morning early, used, and then the offender lacked even the courtesy to return it to the beach but rather left it adrift when leaving the harbor. He will be spoken to personally, but among gentlemen, such a thing should not have happened at all.
