NOTICE

Attached are the results of our 23rd Annual Fall Race Series. We had 178 entries and approximately 140 boats raced. Added to our natural attrition rate was the damage incurred by numerous boats from Hurricane Donna. Our sincere condolences to those skippers and we will hope to see you all back in action in the spring of 1961.

This fall series probably produced the best weather we have had in a long time and outside of a few minor occurrences such as SOUVENIR's mast, the races proceeded without incident. However, there could have been an extremely serious collision, which was avoided by a matter of inches. In the Saturday race on the beat up to Constellation, two boats narrowly missed each other simply because there was no one appointed to keep an eye out for other boats. Skippers should take the responsibility themselves to eliminate the possibility of an accident. We have never had one in Off Soundings and we certainly don't want to incur any in the future.

There is always at least one humorous incident and on Friday, Herb Owen produced it from the RAN, flipping over one of his crew members into the drink. That he was picked up at all was probably due to the rule that you must finish with the same number on board as when you start. The poor wretch who went over is still trying to live down this incident.

Many thanks to you all for your contributions during the year which is a major help in enabling us to conduct our general business and the two race series. I think we now have a 98% record of members and guests contributing. Again many thanks - keep up the good work.

Attached you will find the perpetual trophy winners for this year. Trophies will be awarded at the winter meeting in Springfield. All members will be notified of this event and its date. Also, for members, please be advised that dinghy races, luncheon, and cocktails will be held at the Mystic Seaport October 29th. Bring your long underwear. Cards will be sent out on this.

This will be my last bulletin as race secretary; a position I have held for four years. It has been an extremely interesting experience and my sincere thanks to you all for your cooperation. The help and counsel I have had from our past Commodore John Fales and from our present Commodore Ted Daggett have been invaluable in making this job go smoothly.
