- Request a resolution from the Board that multihulls be equipped to the NEMA standard and that NEMA handicaps be used without PE.
- Monohull—Changed title Of OSC Standards to monohull, changed charts requirement to paper charts.

Sailing Instructions–

- Same physical changes as Notice of Race
- 720 rule reinstated
- This allowed simplification of the description of the OSC alternate 10-minute penalty.
- Eliminated references to Class B.
- The starting sequence now indicates 12 classes assuming elimination of Class B and continuation of Class J.
- Monohull/Multihull references added where appropriate.
- Added sail regulations for NS classes to SI.

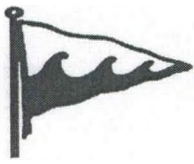

- 3.13.1 “crash bulkheads”**
- 3.14.4 Special requirements for pulpits, stanchions, lifelines on multihulls**
- 3.15.2d “aft nets”**
- 3.22 Hand holds**
