MEASURER'S REPORT for the year 1975

During 1975 the Measurer processed 243 new measurements and 46 revisions to still-valid certificates. About 13% had errors serious enough to affect the rating.

In March all ratings expiring after May 31, 1975 were re-calculated to incorporate changes to the Measurement Rule. Postal card notices of the revised ratings were sent to 500 owners late in March. During the winter months the effect of the 1975 rule changes and the need for further changes are being studied.

The Measurer has begun the steps necessary to get all measured data and ratings on the Greene Plastics computer. A disk-pack has been acquired and the programming is in process.

On December 31st, the active file was purged of 65 certificates that had expired in 1975 and for which new measurements had not been received, leaving in the file valid certificates for 639 yachts.
