This year the Off Soundings Club will return home to Mystic Seaport and hold its annual meeting and Spring Dinner on Saturday April 7, 2001. The annual meeting for members will be held at the Mallory Building at 1800.

Cocktails also will be served in the Mallory Building at 1815 on a buy-your-own basis. "Rock of Ages" will provide music during cocktails. At approximately 1920 we will leave the Mallory Building and proceed to the River Room in the Seamen's Inn where a fine dinner with all the trimmings will be served at 1930. Members, spouses, and guests are cordially invited to cocktails, dinner or both. If you plan to sit with a group, come early and stake out a table.

This year we are offering a choice of appetizers, including bisque, chowder, fresh fruit and a tortellini. The main course has two selections: prime rib at \$36.50 and a filet of Norwegian Salmon, pan roasted, basil encrusted at \$33.50 per plate. Choice of desserts are a parfait, torte, or seasonal berries. Prices include tax and gratuity. These prices are for advanced payment. We will charge \$38.50 and \$35.50 respectively if paid at the door. You should call prior to Thursday, April 5<sup>th</sup> to make sure that we can make arrangements to accommodate you.

The after dinner program, starting at 2030, will include the awarding of perpetual trophies. All members and guests are cordially invited to this program whether or not they have dinner tickets.

If you receive a trophy, please be present for the award or have a designated person accept it for you. This helps our Awards Chairman and assures the safe transport of our valuable trophies.
