### ASSEMBLY

NEW YORK  
7 JULY, 1931

THE YACHTS TAKING PART IN THE ANNUAL CRUISE WILL ASSEMBLE AT NEWPORT, THURSDAY, 13 AUGUST, BY 6 P. M.

THE CAPTAINS' MEETING WILL BE HELD ON BOARD THE "VIKING" AT 9 P. M. AND CAPTAINS WILL REPORT TO THE COMMODORE ON BOARD THE "VIKING" AT THAT TIME. CAPTAINS AND THEIR GUESTS WILL BE WELCOME ON THE FLAGSHIP OR ON HER TENDER, THE "WAYFARER", AT ALL TIMES THROUGHOUT THE CRUISE.

### SIGNALS

ALL SIGNALS WILL BE HOISTED AND ALL GUNS WILL BE FIRED BY THE "WAYFARER".

WHEN A SIGNAL FOR GETTING UNDERWAY IS HOISTED TWO GUNS IN SUCCESSION WILL BE FIRED TO CALL ATTENTION. WHEN ANY OTHER SIGNAL REFERRED TO IN THIS ORDER IS HOISTED ONE GUN WILL BE FIRED TO CALL ATTENTION.

THE CODE LETTERS C A WITH A SIGNAL DISPLAYED SIMULTANEOUSLY INDICATING THE NEXT PORT, WILL BE HOISTED AT THE HOUR PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED FOR GETTING UNDERWAY.

THE SIGNAL C B WILL INDICATE A POSTPONEMENT OF THE TIME FOR GETTING UNDERWAY. THE SIGNAL C Y WITH A TIME SIGNAL DISPLAYED SIMULTANEOUSLY, WILL INDICATE A NEW TIME FOR GETTING UNDERWAY.

THE WARNING SIGNAL FOR A RACE ON ANY RUN WILL BE HOISTED BY THE RACE COMMITTEE BOAT AT THE POINT INDICATED IN THE INSTRUCTIONS, ONE HOUR AFTER THE SIGNAL FOR GETTING UNDERWAY.

A REASONABLE TIME, HOWEVER, AS WEATHER AND OTHER CONDITIONS MAY REQUIRE, WILL BE ALLOWED YACHTS (WHICH GET UNDERWAY PROMPTLY) TO REACH THE VICINITY OF THE STARTING LINE BEFORE THE SIGNAL IS MADE.

### INSTRUCTIONS

THE RACE COMMITTEE WILL ISSUE INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PORT TO PORT RACES AND FOR OTHER RACING EVENTS.

THE RACE COMMITTEE WILL ESTABLISH A LINE FOR THE START OF EACH RACE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUCH INSTRUCTIONS.

SATURDAY 15 AUGUST	VINEYARD HAVEN	THE SQUADRON WILL GET UNDER WAY AT 6 A. M. FOR THE RUN TO PROVINCETOWN. THE RACES FOR THE COMMODORE'S CUPS WILL BE SAILED FOR ON THIS RUN.
SUNDAY 16 AUGUST	PROVINCETOWN	THE SQUADRON WILL REMAIN AT ANCHOR IN PROVINCETOWN HARBOR. YACHTS WILL DRESS SHIP AT 8 A. M.
MONDAY 17 AUGUST	PROVINCETOWN	THE SQUADRON WILL GET UNDER WAY AT 8 A. M. FOR THE RUN TO MARBLEHEAD. THE RACES FOR THE NAVY CHALLENGE CUPS WILL BE SAILED FOR ON THIS RUN.
TUESDAY 18 AUGUST	MARBLEHEAD	RACE OFF MARBLEHEAD FOR CUPS OFFERED BY THE EASTERN YACHT CLUB.
WEDNESDAY 19 AUGUST	MARBLEHEAD	THE SQUADRON WILL GET UNDER WAY AT 7:30 A. M. FOR THE RUN TO THE CAPE COD CANAL. THE RACES FOR THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF THE U. S. NAVY CHALLENGE CUPS WILL BE SAILED FOR ON THIS RUN.
THURSDAY 20 AUGUST	WING'S NECK	THE SQUADRON WILL GET UNDER WAY AT 8 A. M. FOR THE RUN FROM THE HEAD OF BUZZARD'S BAY TO NEWPORT. THE RACES FOR THE REAR COMMODORE'S CUPS WILL BE SAILED FOR ON THIS RUN.
FRIDAY 21 AUGUST	NEWPORT	THE RACES FOR THE ASTOR CUPS WILL BE SAILED OFF NEWPORT. THE WARNING SIGNAL WILL BE HOISTED AT NOON. YACHTS WILL ANCHOR IN NEWPORT HARBOR AFTER THE RACES.
SATURDAY 22 AUGUST	NEWPORT	THE RACE FOR THE KING'S CUP AND A RACE FOR YACHTS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE KING'S CUP WILL BE SAILED OFF NEWPORT. THE WARNING SIGNAL FOR THE KING'S CUP RACE WILL BE HOISTED AT NOON. THE WARNING SIGNAL FOR THE RACE FOR YACHTS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE KING'S CUP WILL BE HOISTED AT 12:30 P. M. YACHTS WILL ANCHOR IN NEWPORT HARBOR AFTER THE RACES.



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
