Dear Mathew,

Last fall your letter, enclosure (1), requested payment for security for two nights, extra launch service, minister services and mooring fees, in addition to a liquor invoice of \$1762.13. Our letter of 15 October, enclosure (2), promptly paid the liquor charge, the minister fees and the mooring fees. This left a disputed amount of \$700 for the "added security" and the extra launch service.


Since then I have researched the mooring charges and have determined independently from the owners in question and the OSC Race Secretary, that the boats "Fiddlers Green" and "Misty" were not members of the Off Soundings racing fleet. Also, our Board of Governors has discussed the matter of the security and launch charges. While we are in disagreement that these charges were agreed to ahead of time, the Board has authorized payment in the Corinthian spirit of good relations between our clubs. I believe this is consistent with discussions between our Commodore Wes Maxwell, John Lockwood ( a liaison for both clubs) and yourself.

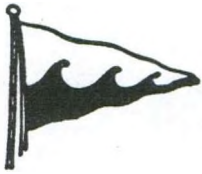
