An agenda for the Board meeting is enclosed.

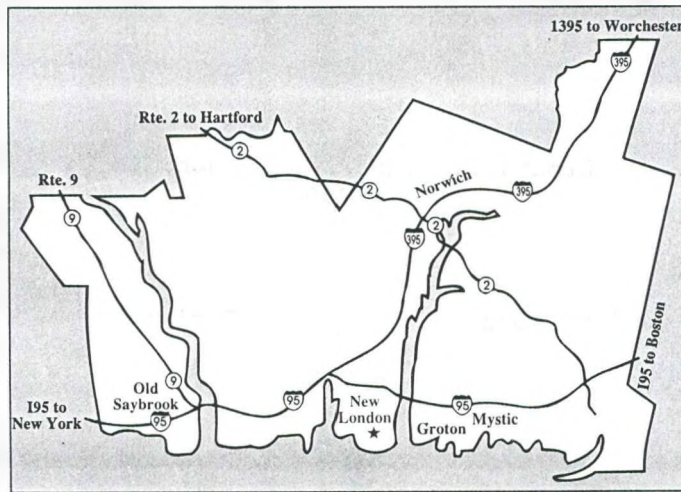

**From: New York**

Take I-95 north to exit 82. Turn right onto Broad St. At second traffic light, turn right on Coleman St.\*

**From Boston**

Take I-95 south to exit 83. Turn left on Coleman St.\*

\*Follow Coleman St. to the end, turn left on Bank St., at second traffic light turn right on Montauk Ave. Follow Montauk to the end and turn right on Pequot Ave., and take your second right on Guthrie place. The Lighthouse Inn is directly ahead.
